- 3. Read through some of the lists on spiritual gifts (Romans 12:6-18, 1 Corinthians 12:8-10, 27-28). What gifts do you think you have been given?
- 4. If someone didn't know what spiritual gift(s) they have, how would you suggest that they would figure that out?
