Discussion Questions

- 1. What are some of the images that come to mind when you think about heaven? Where do you think your primary perception of heaven has come from?
- 2. Does it challenge your mindset to hear that our permanent destination as God's people is not heaven, but a renewed earth? In what ways does that change how you think about the afterlife?
- 3. Read Philippians 3:8-11. What does Paul consider to be of most value? What is he willing to do to make sure he experiences that reality? Do you think that you would be willing to suffer like Christ to attain the resurrection of the dead? What do you think that means? Why do you think Paul thinks that is worthwhile?
- 4. Read Philippians 3:20-21. Our citizenship is in heaven, but we are to colonize earth with heaven's values. In what ways can you live this out in your daily life?
