



Part 6: Value

We are all worshippers. We sacrifice things like our time, attention and finances for the things that we believe are most valuable. What are you worshipping? Is it worth the sacrifice?

Scripture: Exodus 12:21-23, John 19:28-34, Revelation 5:6-13

Bottom Line: If you want to see the heart of God as clearly as you can, you need to look at Jesus.

Discussion Questions

1. Have you ever bought something that was really expensive for you, but you felt like it was totally worth it? What was it? What made it worth the sacrifice?
2. Worship is showing how much worth something has to us. One of the ways to know what you are worshipping in life is to evaluate who or what you make big sacrifices for. What are the things in your life that you are tempted to worship (things that you sacrifice attention, finances, time, etc. for)? How do you think you can tell when you sacrifice an appropriate amount for someone or something, and when you have started to worship that thing?
3. Have you ever thought about the ways that we show God what He is worth to us? What are some of the ways that you/we typically worship God?
4. Read Revelation 5:8-13. This is a description of heavenly worship of Jesus. What are the things that Jesus (the Lamb) is said to be worthy of? Try to picture this scene. Describe it in your own words. What images come to mind? There are a number of words repeated in the worship of the angels. Why do you think those words are important? Talk about each one and discuss what it means that Jesus is worthy of them, or that they belong to him.
5. What are some ways that you think we should show God what he is worth to us?

Moving Forward

Worship takes many forms. We worship through singing, studying scripture, loving and caring for people, and many other ways. What are some ways that you can make sure that your everyday life is characterized by worship of God? Are there ways that you have learned to sense and express the awe of God?
